
## 'M'EN FOUS

I live in squat. We arrange gigs in our living room, it's a good place. Here's not anymore many squats, only three in Lausanne, bigger cities like Zurich, Basel, Geneve is some too. I thing squatting has seen better days, its happening still but smaller scales. It's not anymore any common movement, its not been for ages. Problem is that there's no space in Switzerland, no empty palace to squat. Country is small and over crowded and everybody needs place to live. But at least it's possible if really want so...

You've been playing gigs around Europe, at least cd's thanks list tell so. Have you play elsewhere or any plans?

Yeah, we play a lot cos we like it. We don't have any plans,

just one thing at the time. Were touring in England (again) and Austria in June and Finland in July. Its hard to make plans more than few months ahead. Roberto would like to play outside of Europe, but cos he's not in the band at the moment lets see what he has in his mind when he is coming back, if he's coming back...

## What else you do beside J'm'en fous and what would you like to do?

hmmm...Im welding a lot, building solar panels, mostly in summer times. I make video engineering to dance show...which is terrible...I like to tour more with the band cos I really like it and we're here only once...
